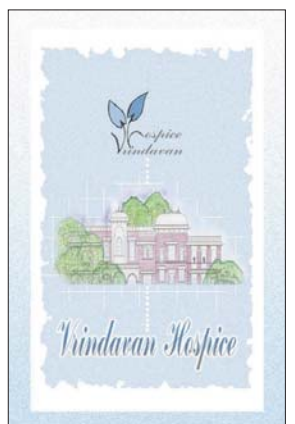

Vrindavan Hospice - A Helping Hand During the Final Journey



The Vrindavan Hospice, a project of Bhaktivedanta Hospital, is dedicated to providing holistic end-of-life care for the followers of His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada in the supportive, Krishna conscious environment of its inpatient facility in Vrindavan, India.

Presently, the hospice is under construction on over one acre of land in an area near ISKCON Vrindavan, UP, India and is scheduled to complete by December 2007. When completed the project will comprise over 30000 sq. ft of building area surrounded by beautiful garden. The building has been designed to have 16 individual rooms for hospice patient. Eight rooms will be completely outfitted in the first phase and the balance rooms will be left for finishing work later.

All facilities required for the care and comfort of devotees are provided including two well furnished guest rooms, central heating and AC, audio-video facilities, library, hydrotherapy and massage facilities, mortuary, ambulance, fire fighting system, OPD clinic with separate waiting area for new hospice patients and many other such facilities. Staffed with a professional medical team and trained volunteers, the Vrindavan Hospice will address the physical, emotional, social, and spiritual needs of those devotees diagnosed with terminal illnesses, as well as the needs of the patients' family members and loved ones.

Barsana Eye Camp 2007

A team of 17 finest ophthalmic surgeons from Mumbai, 40 doctors and 270 volunteers worked steadily day and night from 1 – 16 Feb' 07 at the eye camp in Barsana. During the first few days, 2536 patients were examined at the OPD (Out Patient Dept) and finally 611 eye surgeries were performed at the site and 31 patients were selected to be taken to Mumbai for specialized surgeries like that for one eyed patients and children.

The hospice shall also make available bereavement services including individual and family counseling, loss-related publications, funeral and memorial services and other resources to assist the family in living with the experience of grief and loss, while celebrating the unique spiritual benefits of leaving this world in the sacred land of Krishna, Sri Vrindavan Dham.

Vrindavan Hospice will provide an education center with a specialist library. The center will support hospice education through organizing courses, conferences and workshops and publishing training and resource materials. In addition, the Vrindavan Hospice Outpatient Clinic will provide medical treatment to all comers, regardless of social or economic.
